Materials List

This sampler was made from one layer cake (pack of 10" squares all from the same line PLUS $\frac{1}{2}$ yd of background fabric (creamy white in sample)

Or choose scraps from your collection!



- *Tools to make it easier to make the circles: Karen Kay Buckley's Perfect Circles
- *Applique Circle Template Sheet
- *Perfect Stems (iron proof plastic lengths of different sizes for pressing your stems)
- *fabric pencil that will show up on your background fabric
- *50 wt thread colors to match your applique fabrics
- *Applique needles, size 10 and needle threader
- *Thimble if you like to use one
- *scissors
- **If you need reading glasses for fine work, make sure to bring them along 😊

*****I will be teaching the back basting method of hand applique. It includes using a sewing machine to stitch on the back of your background fabric...you'll see 😊 . I will bring a machine to use so you don't have to bring yours. I will monitor the class size to determine how many machines I will need....
